Under the future concession contract, visitors who currently arrive by private car or the existing shuttle system will be required to have an arrival reservation to visit the park, and the concessioner will provide the necessary reservation system to facilitate this. In tandem with the reservation service, the concessioner's onsite management of visitor arrivals will allow for an orderly and pleasant visit to the park.
